- To be updated on and comply with all relevant health and safety legislation and regulations as well as other standards for our business. Also to encourage even tougher voluntary standards in dialogue with the customer whenever possible.
- To implement, and continuously improve, a health and safety management system of routines and procedures that serve to identify and prevent the consequences of unsafe actions that can lead to accidents and ill health, as well as to prepare, train for and respond to emergency situations.
- To ensure that effective safety devices and personal protective equipment (PPE) are available to and used by all our employees and ensure that any subcontractors working onboard do the same.
- To provide adequate information, training and resources to ensure that all employees can perform their work safely and efficiently. All personnel working onboard, including our contractors, are to be given necessary introduction of the vessel before starting work, including the health and safety principles that apply there.
- All SweOffshore employees are responsible for identifying any potentially unsafe conditions or unlawful practices and to undertake corrective measures. We promote a proactive incident reporting culture where any member of the personnel should feel free to report on potential risks and feel that their opinion is taken into account.
